As the holiday season approaches and 2013 comes to an end, the Las Vegas Valley Humane Society will adopt out close to 400 dogs and cats, rescue more than 200 injured animals off of the streets, and spay and neuter almost 2000 cats and dogs during this year.

You have supported us in the past; please support us again this year. Every dollar makes a difference. Although we are continuing to reduce our expenditures, revenues are continuing to decline.

In past Christmas newsletters, wonderful stories of a cat and dog that were saved by LVVHS were highlighted. But one story of one cat or one dog doesn't provide the full scope of what this organization does. So this year pictures of more animals are being highlighted, with the understanding that each of these animals represents so many more. And LVVHS is collaborating with other organizations to insure that more animals are spayed and neutered — so much so that the numbers of animals going into local shelters are dropping dramatically!

Remember that the Las Vegas Valley Humane Society is an all-volunteer organization. Your money does not pay salaries. Your money stays here to help local animals. The animals that it takes in are rescued from here and adopted out here. No funds are received from a national organization nor are we affiliated with any national organization.
